Bus routes



The Co-edo Loop Bus conveniently connects all of Kawagoe's sightseeing spots. There are two different Bus routes, yellow and purple. Both routes start at Kawagoe Station, but they run in opposite directions and have slightly different stops. Both return to Kawagoe station.

The purple line runs in a clockwise direction and its first stop is Kura no machi (Old Town). The yellow line runs in a counter-clockwise direction and its first stop is Kita-in Temple.

Please find the bus stop nearest your destination and choose the route that is best for you.



There are several styles of Co-edo Loop Buses including our vintage front cab buses, famous from their many TV appearances, and modern two-door buses; however, you can ride on any of these buses, which are easily identified by their Co-edo logo. Try and ride on different buses, to better enjoy your visit, and let us know your favorite!

Bus fare



IC cards such as SUICA and PASMO are not accepted, so please prepare some coins for your fare. Single rides are just ¥170 or ¥180. Please pay your fare when you get off and let the driver know where you wish get off by pressing the nearest stop button.

► About the Daily Pass

With our convenient and economical Daily Pass, you can enjoy unlimited Co-edo Loop Bus service for the whole day; there really is no better or easier way to see all of Kawagoe. To use your Daily Pass, please show it to the driver when you get off and the driver will detach and stamp it at your first ride. Please don't detach the perforated sheet portion yourself, let the driver. On your next ride, just show your stamped ticket to the driver as you exit. That's it; now enjoy your stay and be careful not to lose your Daily Pass, as you'll need it to see all of Kawagoe's many charms!

► About Free Coupons (Seibu and Odakyu railway companies)

Your ticket has two parts—a large ticket and a smaller ticket. When you first board a Co-edo Loop Bus, you must give the smaller ticket to the driver. When you wish to board another Co-edo Loop Bus, simply show the large ticket to the driver and be seated.
